Subject: Guidelines for Teaching, Learning, and Examinations at Prince of Songkla University in Response to the Impact of the Unrest in the Middle East

Pursuant to the Cabinet Resolution dated 10 March 2026, urgent measures have been approved to mitigate the impact of the unrest in the Middle East, and to avert a potential domestic energy crisis, with particular emphasis on the implementation of energy conservation measures across all sectors.

In accordance with the Cabinet Resolution, Prince of Songkla University has established the following operational guidelines for personnel:

1. All faculties and campuses should consider adjusting the format of teaching and examinations as appropriate. Instruction and assessment may be conducted either on-site or online, depending on the nature of the course, course content, and prevailing circumstances, in order to ensure the continuity of teaching and assessment, and to maximize the educational benefit for students.

2. For courses that require on-site instruction or assessment, such as those involving laboratory work, professional skill training in specialized disciplines, or practical training courses, such activities may proceed as appropriate. In doing so, strict adherence to the energy conservation measures prescribed for government agencies shall be maintained, and care shall be taken to ensure that these arrangements do not impose an undue burden on students and other relevant stakeholders.

3. Final examinations for the second semester of Academic Year 2025 shall be conducted on-site as scheduled, in accordance with the academic calendar established by the Registrar's Office, Education and Innovative Learning Academy.
